James Montgomery himself thought that if his name would live on, it would be through his hymns. Several, such as *Angels from the Realms of Glory*, *Hail to the Lord's Anointed*, and *Stand Up and Bless the Lord* prove his thoughts correct. When discovering the words to *Remember Thee*, I thought one more should be heard and remembered. Montgomery's verse seemed to me the perfect setting for Communion and especially for Good Friday. After reminding us of Christ's final hours, he personalizes the final thought by having us echo the words and plea of the thief on the cross.

We are grateful to Tom Magee, owner of Classic Organs of Indiana, for this new music. He said: "The hymn tune DLRohy seemed quite easy to write and reflect the mood of the verse. It is in Common Meter so the tune can be used with many other hymns. You will note that I included chord symbols with the music. They have a two-fold purpose. I used them as a guide for the improvisation interlude you hear in the video or recording. And, realizing that many congregations use instruments other than organ, my thought was that this hymn could still be used in a quiet and contemplative style with acoustic guitar."
